Miles of Smiles, Ltd. is collaborating with the Springfield Public Schools (SPS), the Sangamon County Department of Public Health (SCDPH) and the Central Counties Health Centers, Inc. (CCHC) to get the needed dental treatment completed for children served in the school setting.



Approximately one fourth of all children receiving preventive dental services at school need follow up care. There are several obstacles in their ability to access such care, including getting to a local dental office. It's been a couple of years in the works with all community partners involved.

And now, Miles of Smiles, Ltd. is pleased to share a photo of the transportation van that is being used to get the children to the CCHC clinic, providing them with a true dental home in their own community.

Located in Springfield, III., CCHC provides quality, affordable health and oral health care to Springfield residents and those in surrounding counties who lack health or dental insurance or do not have adequate coverage. The Wisdom Tooth Award is granted to an organization that significantly improves the oral health of Illinois children, and CCHC was selected from 17 applicants. CCHC will use the Wisdom Tooth Award to help fund its "Check Up Pick Up" Dental Transportation Program and expand its dental services to provide comprehensive care to more children.

CCHC provides affordable health and oral care to Illinois residents who lack insurance or do not have adequate coverage. The team came up with the idea of the "Check Up Pick Up" program when they realized that many of the children referred to the program for dental care never came in for an appointment because they lacked transportation. Thanks to Delta Dental of Illinois Foundation's Wisdom Tooth Award, CCHC has a new van to launch the program, and the van is being used to pick up kids at their schools for their dental appointments and take them back afterwards.
